

## The Wheeler-Farley House

(some things you may want to bring, also important notes and some things provided)

### Some things to bring:

**Blankets:** Most beds have comforters and bedspreads, but we had to stop providing blankets due to the extra time required for CDC COVID protocol cleaning which we still follow.

**Light jacket:** it can cool at night even during the summer months

**Extra bath towels and wash cloths:** We provide 16 towels and 32 wash cloths and there is a washer and dryer, but you may want to bring extra.

**Rags to clean up muddy messes/etc.:** Please do not use our towels/wash cloths for this purpose!

**Laundry Detergent/Fabric Softener**

**Dishwasher Soap – liquid or pods**

**Soap: Bar soap;** Liquid pump bottles are provided

**Shampoo**

**Extra trash bags:** 30-gallon size (5 are provided under the sink)

**Extra toilet paper:** we provide 2 rolls in each of the 4 bathrooms.

**Beach Towels**

**Kayaks and Canoes:** due to liability we are not able to provide guests with access to our watercraft. There is a livery 2 ½ miles south.

**Life Jackets;** can wade from the shore; no current next to shore on normal days but need water shoes.

**Water Shoes**

**Hiking Shoes**

**Bug Spray**

**Sunscreen**

**Games: Croquet, wiffle ball, soccer balls, bocce ball, board games, cards checkers, chess, puzzles, etc.**

**DVD/Blu ray movies/Music CDS**

**Fishing equipment/fishing license**

**Kitchen and Food Items:** Spices, coffee, coffee filters, napkins, paper towels, aluminum foil, plastic wrap, paper plates, food, beverages

**Kitchen and Food Items:** although kitchen is fully stocked with utensils, pots, pans, toaster, microwave, blender, flatware, baking pans, etc., bring Spices, coffee, coffee filters, napkins, paper towels, aluminum foil, plastic wrap, paper plates, baggies.

**Coolers and extra ice** – to take drinks, food to riverbank or front yard patio and to handle provided fridges overflow. The fridge has a high-volume ice maker. There is also an extra fridge in the lower level and a beverage cooler in the kitchen.

**Transportable Chairs:** the house has 10 folding cloth chairs that can be taken down to the river. We have many other outdoor chairs, but they have to stay in the front of the house and on the porch. It is hard and inconvenient to take them down to the river!

**Laptop computer and other devices** – we have Wi-Fi and broadband internet

**Binoculars:** There are many beautiful birds, including bald eagles and other wildlife all around. Binoculars make it that much more fun to see them “up close.”

**Charcoal/Lighter Fluid:** grilling utensils are in a kitchen drawer. Grill cleaning brushes are hanging next to the grill

**Wood:** If you live in PA, you may bring firewood to burn in the outdoor fire pit and indoor fireplace. If you are coming from outside PA, it is **illegal** to bring wood across the state line. Many stores close to The Wheeler-Farley House sell aged split firewood.

**Splitting Maul:** you may use any cut up wood and/or downed dead trees if you want to bring a chain saw.

### **Other items provided and important items to note:**

**Emergency Numbers:** are pinned to kitchen cork board. Includes medical and hospital locations.

**Generac Whole House Generator:** have peace of mind that you will have electricity in the event of an outage. It automatically turns on and will switch back to normal electric (utility power) once power is restored.

**Trash:** do not leave bags outside due to wildlife. Deposit in the dumpster at George's Little Store (2.5 miles S) or The Trading Post (4.5 miles N). There is a per bag cost of approx. \$5/bag. And dump your final bags before the cars are loaded so no trash is left behind.

**Exterminator:** we have a service every 2 months year-round to control bugs and pests. Monthly during the season, the grounds are sprayed for mosquitos and ticks.

**Things to do:** Kitchen corkboard is full of ideas. There is also a binder with information.

**A/C:** in every room except walkout lower level which stays cool but has fans to use for extremely hot days.

**Fully outfitted beds:** waterproof mattress pads, fitted sheet, sheet, bedspreads/comforters (except for lower-level futons), pillowcases. Again, note no blankets.

**Fully equipped kitchen:** includes Microwave, drip coffee pot, blender, fridge with large capacity ice maker.

**Water:** We have a well that provides clean drinking water via a commercial grade treatment system.

**3 refrigerators:** one in Kitchen, one at bottom of stairs in lower level and a beverage fridge in the kitchen

**Two 8' Outdoor picnic tables that seat approx. 8 each.**

**Large Stone firepit:** with ample wood benches and extra plastic chairs

**Large Stone Grill from 1930!** Can use charcoal or wood. No gas grills on property.

**Front porch swing**

**Small hard plastic children's pool**

**Hoses attached to outside faucets**

**TVs in each room except for the smallest BR with 2 twins**

**Blu-Ray in main living room and lower level**
